We are also grateful to all of our volunteers that still continued to volunteer to help us fulfill our Mission, even in creative ways. We are truly grateful."

After a 2020 calendar year that saw TeamSmile severely impacted by the pandemic, the 2021 calendar year saw TeamSmile adapting and emerging from the pandemic, ultimately conducting programs in 16 cities, and additionally serving 2,427 children through the newly-created TeamSmile Virtual Oral Health Education and product distribution, in partnership with the University of Buffalo School of Dentistry.

Through a combination of Phase II, Phase II+ and traditional, full programs, we conducted 16 programs, served 2098 children and provided over \$615 thousand in free dental care and oral health education.

Throughout this 2021 Annual Report, you'll see much of our detailed statistical information, and you'll note many improvements and enhancements to our overall TeamSmile operation. 2021 was a year of adaptation, while navigating through various stages of the pandemic. There were challenges in dealing with unknowns, yet with guidance from the TeamSmile Board of Directors, we managed our way through the pandemic safely. If the pandemic will fade, we are positioned to phase back into full TeamSmile programs in 2022.










Flouride was the most common service needed by a child in 2021 with a total of 2059


